

## **Terms of Participation**

Jerusalem Post Ltd., Company No. 512311598 (hereinafter: the "Company"), hereby invites you to purchase a ticket to the conference and to participate therein.

The purchase of a ticket and participation in the conference constitute your full agreement to the terms and conditions set forth below.

Admission to the conference is subject to compliance with all applicable laws, venue regulations, and security procedures.

The Company and/or the conference organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to, or remove from the conference, any participant who violates these terms or behaves in a disruptive, unlawful, dangerous, or otherwise inappropriate manner, without entitlement to any refund.

Participants undertake to comply with the instructions of event staff, ushers, and security personnel at all times.

The bringing of weapons, hazardous materials, sound equipment, banners, political materials, food or beverages, or any other item deemed prohibited by the Company or the venue is strictly forbidden. Admission is subject to a security screening.

Photography, audio or video recording, and/or broadcasting of any part of the conference is prohibited without the Company's prior written consent.

The conference may be photographed, recorded, and/or otherwise documented by the Company. Participation in the conference constitutes the participant's consent to such documentation and to the use thereof for lawful promotional and commercial purposes.

The Company and/or the organizers reserve the right to modify the date, venue, program, content, and/or speakers of the conference, or to cancel the conference due to force majeure or any circumstances beyond their reasonable control.

## **Transaction Cancellation and Refund Policy**

In accordance with the Israeli Consumer Protection Law, 1981, and the regulations promulgated thereunder:

### **Remote Sales Transaction (Purchase via Website or Telephone)**

A remote sales transaction may be canceled within 14 days from the date of the transaction or from the date of receipt of the written transaction details, whichever is later, provided that the cancellation is made at least seven (7) business days prior to the scheduled conference date.

Cancellation fees shall not exceed 5% of the ticket price or NIS 100, whichever is lower.

### **Senior Citizens, Persons with Disabilities, and New Immigrants**

Eligible individuals may cancel a remote sales transaction within four (4) months from the date of the transaction or from the date of receipt of the written transaction details, whichever is later, subject to the presentation of appropriate documentation and provided that the cancellation is made at least seven (7) business days prior to the conference date.

No cancellation shall be permitted within seven (7) business days preceding the conference.

In the event that the conference is canceled by the organizers, participants shall be entitled to a full refund within a reasonable time.

In the event that the conference is postponed, the ticket shall remain valid for the rescheduled date. A participant who is unable to attend on the new date may cancel the ticket and receive a full refund within the timeframe specified in the postponement notice.

Exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute arising out of or relating to the conference and/or these Terms shall be vested in the competent courts of Tel Aviv, Israel, and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Israel.
